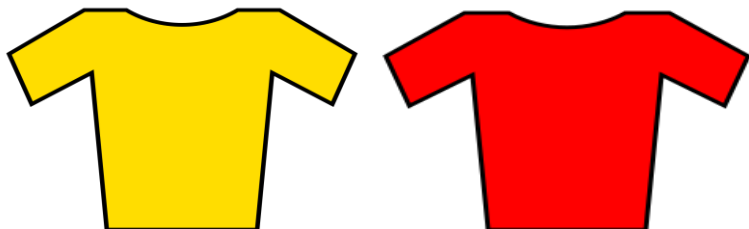




### **GOAL Jersey Day**
