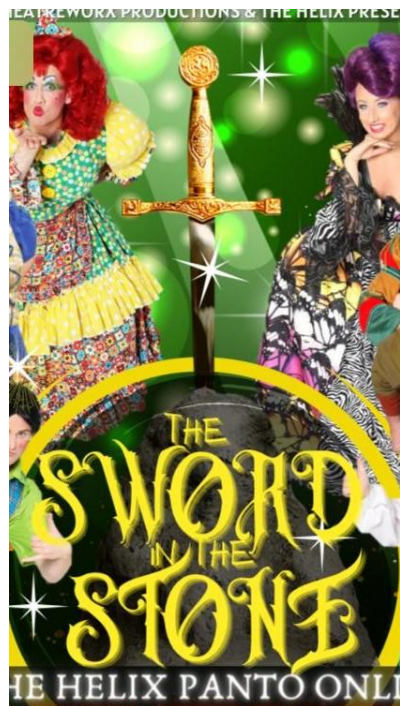
We are always very appreciate of any support from companies such as Zimmer and if you work for a multinational or other and feel that maybe they could help out the school in some way please let us know.
