## Covid – 19

As you will be aware Covid cases are very much increasing everywhere at the moment.

If there is a Covid case in your child's class, you'll be notified and will be given instructions accordingly.

If your child has been diagnosed as Covid Positive please let the school know.

Antigen tests are only to be used if your child has no symptoms. PCR tests must be undertaken if your child is displaying symptoms.

We will keep you updated and informed as usual.



As the weather gets colder you may wish to encourage your child to wear warm layers under their school uniform. Windows will remain open throughout the day in order to ensure adequate ventilation. Jackets are allowed to be worn in class if necessary as the winter progresses, however if wearing a jacket in class your child will not get the benefit of it when going outside.
