Scoil Iósaif Naofa Well Being Survey feedback

Many thanks for your engagement with the survey we sent out last week. There was a very high engagement level (60%) and we are very appreciative of you taking the few minutes to respond.

It genuinely does help us with our planning.

We were really happy with the feedback. For most questions asked over 98% of responses were positive.

The responses that jumped out at me which we will take into consideration are

- how additional support for students is organised in the school (16.2 % are not aware of above)
- Child Protection Procedures in the school and the name of the Designated Liaison Person (Maeve Meeneghan Principal) 16% are not aware of above
- The school communicates with me when things are going well e.g. to acknowledge my child's progress and achievements 9% answered 'No'

The school is active in preventing and tackling bullying 89% of respondents said yes and 10.1% replied 'sometimes'.

*** Please communicate with us if you have any concerns re bullying. It is a very complex area however we endeavour to always listen and support where we can.
