February 1 traditionally marks the beginning of Spring in Ireland. St Brigid's day traditionally sees people make Saint Brigid's crosses and is now Ireland's newest public holiday (5th Feb).

The cross is usually put up in homes above windows or doorways and is believed to keep harm away from the household. St. Brigid is said to have invented the cross herself while attending a sickbed and picking up rushes from the floor to craft them into a sacred cross. Taking up the tradition in its many forms focuses the mind in the meditation of craft, and connects our winter minds to the great wheel that turns and is slowly bringing us into the spring of renewal. This year each class will learn about St Brigid and some classes will have the opportunity to make St Brigid's crosses in class.
